

Here are some pictures of the "Lautrette" air cleaner base, seen from below



Here it is, set to 'Summer'



And here it is set to 'Winter'.





This is the control lever, set for summer,



and set for winter.

The downwards-facing snout mates with a corresponding duct on the exhaust heat shield.

The cold-air intake has a number of holes in its flat upper surface. May this be to do with noise control?

The silentbloc suspension of the filter is different from that used with the M.I.O.M. (Gris rosé) type.

The filter element of the M.I.O.M. is interchangeable with the Lautrette, but looks different.
